


Dismantle the original headlamp


V-Rod

- 1. Loosen screws (5)
- 2. Disconnect plugs (35,36) and unscrew small lamp (43), remove headlamp.
- 3. Loosen screws (3) and remove holder (30).



Night Rod


- 1. Loosen screw (8) and nut (11).
- 2. Disconnect plug (4) and remove headlight and mask.
- 3. Loosen screws (1) and remove original holder (32).





Fitting the "New Night Rod Style" headlamp mask

- 1. Fix the bracket (10) to the motorbike with the screws (13).
- 2. Fix the bracket (19) with the screws (15) at the bottom of the triple clamp.
- 3. Screw the brackets together with the screws (17) and nuts (18), additionally fix the bracket bracket with the screw (16).
- 4. Pull the cables through the opening of the bracket (10) and connect them to the headlamp additionally for NightRod: clamp the adapter cable harness (HD-UNI011) in between.
- 5. Fix the headlamp to the mask holder (12) with the screws (5).
- 6. Fasten the new mask to the mask holder (12) with the screws (14).






Note

After mounting, it is necessary to readjust the headlight range:

- 1. Horizontal line
- 2. Vertical line
- 3. 7,6m
- 4. Height of main beam lamp
- 5. 53,3mm below height of main beam lamp



We recommend using a medium-strength screw lock (e.g. LOCTITE 243, blue) for all screws.
